The main goal of this training programme is to increase students' awareness on the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).



Implementation and approaches

Pontificia Comillas University collaborates with the Global Compact through the Department of Economic and Business Ethics and has signed the Principles for Responsible Management Education (PRME).



Within the Business Ethics and Corporate Social Responsibility Class, students of the international group of the Faculty of Economic and Business Sciences have participated in series of participative sessions. Part of the activity consisted on analysing the role that companies plays in order to achieve SDGs. On the basis of participative debates about how companies can contribute to the SDGs, students put the focus on how companies are part of the problem but also part of the solution.

The students mentioned some possible examples for action within companies including fair trade actions, reduction of the carbon footprint and respect for labour rights. These reflection activities and sessions have been complemented by an exhibition about the Sustainable Development Goals, which has occupied the central corridors of the university.
